Page 1 of 1**INFORMATION NOTICE FOR CUSTOMERS**

Dear data subject, we would like to inform you that the “*European Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the Processing of Personal Data and on the free movement of such data*” (hereinafter “GDPR”) contains provisions for the protection of persons and other subjects with regard to the processing of personal data. **MOSSINI S.P.A.**, therefore and pursuant to article 13 of the GDPR, provides you with the following information:

- A. CATEGORIES OF DATA:** the processing may concern your personal data, such as identification data, biographical data and contact data, etc.
- B. DATA CONTROLLER:** The data controller is **MOSSINI S.P.A.**, **31 VIA ROMA - 23855 PESCATO (LC)**, VAT number **0082773015** and may be contacted at the telephone number **0341367397** or at the e-mail **info@mossini.com**
- C. SOURCE OF THE PERSONAL DATA:** The personal data in the possession of the Controller are collected directly from the data subject.
- D. PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING OF DATA AND LEGAL BASIS:** the personal data are processed by the Controller for the following purposes:
- **Purposes related to legal obligations.**
 - **Purposes related to the management of the contractual and/or pre-contractual relationship and the provision of the products/services:** establishment, management and dissolution of the contractual and commercial relationship; fulfilment of accounting and tax obligations; management of disputes; provision of services; disclosure of your data to possible partners of the Controller for the execution of contractual and/or pre-contractual obligations.
- E. RECIPIENTS OF THE DATA:** To the extent that this is pertinent to the purposes of processing, your data may be disclosed to various recipients, such as public and private bodies by legal obligation or disclosed to subjects who are instrumental for the achievement of the aforementioned purposes, internal or external to the Controller, including but not limited to collaborators, freelance professionals, insurance companies, insurance intermediaries, legal firms, technical partners, banking institutions, etc.
- F. TRANSFER OF THE DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES:** The data collected shall not be transferred to third countries outside the European Union
- G. STORAGE PERIOD:** The data collected will be stored for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed (“principle of storage limitation”, article 5 of the GDPR) or in accordance with the deadlines laid down by law. The obsolescence of the data stored in relation to the purposes for which they were collected shall be verified periodically.
- H. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT:** The data subject has the right at any time to request from the Controller access to his/her data, their rectification or erasure, the limitation of the processing or the possibility to object to the processing, to request the portability of the data, to revoke consent to processing. These and the other rights set forth in the GDPR may be exercised by simple communication to the Controller. The data subject may also lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
- I. OBLIGATION TO DISCLOSE THE DATA:** The disclosure of the personal data is a mandatory requirement for the aforementioned purposes, except for the purposes that are based on consent for which the disclosure of data is optional and your possible refusal will in no way affect the provision of the service.
- J. MEANS OF PROCESSING OF THE DATA:** The personal data that you provide will form the object of processing operations in compliance with the aforementioned regulatory framework and the obligations of confidentiality that underlie the Controller’s activity. The data will be processed with IT tools, on paper-based supports and on any other type of suitable support, in compliance with the adequate technical and organisational safety measures laid down by the GDPR.
